Ministries outside of St. Timothy

In addition to the service opportunities organized and sponsored by groups within the parish, St. Timothy partners with other organizations in our community, primarily by providing volunteers for their work. The Trinity Café ministry is one example. Two sites in the Tampa area provide meals in a café setting seeking to meet the physical need as well as maintain the dignity of those who face hunger. St. Timothy regularly organizes groups to assist with serving a breakfast or noon meal. Additionally, groups have assisted with Habitat for Humanity, volunteered at Guiding Star Tampa, provided food for formerly homeless veterans, participated in blood drives and during the Christmas season, volunteers help at Metropolitan Ministries' holiday tent. These activities are promoted in the parish bulletin and contact information is given there.

Spending Time with God in Prayer

“Love the Lord your God with all your heart.” In order to keep this commandment, we have to spend time in prayer, talking and listening to the Person we love most. Below are some suggested ways to make prayer a priority.

- Attend Mass every Sunday and on Holy Days
- Attend weekday Mass at least once a week
- Spend 15 minutes a day in personal prayer
- Attend Adoration once a month
- Pray together with my loved ones
- Read the Bible for at least one hour a week
- Pray the Rosary at least once a week
- Go to Reconciliation every other month
- Schedule time for a spiritual retreat
- Invite a friend or acquaintance to Mass
- Pray for the sick of our parish

- When I can no longer make any excuses for the size of the gift (large or small).
- When I can honestly state that the gift is sacrificial as I offer it in thanksgiving to God.
- When I can honestly state that in the giving of my gift, I am being honest with God and with self.
