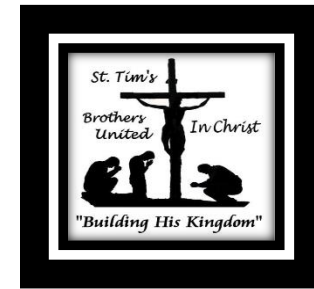
**Our Retreat Master
